Brand Name	Generic Name	Category
<b>Apresoline</b>	hydralazine	Antihypertensive
<b>Avelox</b>	moxifloxacin	Antibiotic
<b>Avodart</b>	dutasteride	Reduces enlarged prostate
<b>Dyazide</b>	triamterene + HCTZ	Antihypertensive (2 diuretics)
<b>Cogentin</b>	benztropine	Anti-Parkinson's
<b>Humira</b>	adalimumab	Immunosuppressive (arthritis, Crohn's disease, and ulcerative colitis)
<b>Dilantin</b>	phenytoin	Anticonvulsant
<b>Ditropan</b>	oxybutynin	Overactive bladder
<b>Keppra</b>	levetiracetam	Anticonvulsant
<b>Victoza</b>	liraglutide	Antidiabetic (Increases insulin secretion from pancreas)
<b>Lioresal</b>	baclofen	Muscle relaxer
<b>Trileptal</b>	oxcarbazepine	Anticonvulsant
<b>Nizoral</b>	ketoconazole	Antifungal
<b>Pamelor</b>	nortriptyline	Antidepressant
<b>Plaquenil</b>	hydroxychloroquine	Arthritis/lupus
<b>Protonix</b>	pantoprazole	Antacid (PPI)
<b>Pyridium</b>	phenazopyridine	Analgesic (urinary)
<b>Strattera</b>	atomoxetine	ADHD (nonscheduled)
<b>Janumet</b>	metformin + sitagliptin	Antidiabetic combination
<b>Jardiance</b>	empagliflozin	Antidiabetic
