

Drugs 1-20 Side Effects

Medication (Brand/Generic Name)	Potential Side Effects
Ambien (Zolpidem)	Drowsiness - Dizziness - Headache - Nausea - Daytime drowsiness or "hangover" feeling - Memory problems - Sleepwalking or other sleep behaviors
Amoxil (Amoxicillin)	Nausea - Vomiting - Diarrhea - Rash - Allergic reactions - Yeast infection (oral or vaginal)
Augmentin (Amoxicillin/Clavulanate)	Same as Amoxil plus potential for additional side effects due to Clavulanate such as Nausea - diarrhea and allergic reactions.
Glucophage (Metformin)	Nausea or vomiting - Diarrhea - Gas or bloating - Weakness or tiredness - Metallic taste in mouth - Low blood sugar (hypoglycemia) when combined with other diabetes medications or excessive alcohol consumption.
Lasix (Furosemide)	Dehydration - Electrolyte imbalance (such as low potassium levels) - Dizziness - Blurred vision - Muscle cramps - Ringing in the ears (tinnitus)
Lipitor (Atorvastatin) Zocor (Simvastatin)	Muscle pain or weakness (myopathy) - Liver problems - Digestive issues (such as nausea, diarrhea, or constipation) - Increased blood sugar levels (especially in individuals with diabetes)
Lopressor (Metoprolol) Tenormin (Atenolol)	Dizziness or lightheadedness - Fatigue - Slow heart rate - Cold hands and feet - Shortness of breath - Depression or confusion (less common)
Microzide (Hydrochlorothiazide)	Dehydration - Electrolyte imbalance (such as low sodium, potassium, or magnesium levels) - Dizziness - Weakness - Increased sensitivity to sunlight - Erectile dysfunction (rare)
Nexium (Esomeprazole) Prilosec (Omeprazole)	Headache - Nausea - Diarrhea - Abdominal pain - Constipation - Dry mouth - Vitamin B12 deficiency (with long-term use)
Norvasc (Amlodipine)	Swelling in the ankles or feet (peripheral edema) - Flushing - Dizziness - Fatigue - Palpitations - Gingival hyperplasia (overgrowth of gum tissue)
Percocet (Oxycodone/Acetaminophen) Vicodin/Lortab (Hydrocodone/Acetaminophen)	Drowsiness - Dizziness - Nausea - Constipation - Respiratory depression (especially with high doses) - Liver toxicity (due to acetaminophen)
Prinivil/Zestril (Lisinopril)	Dry Cough - Dizziness - Hypotension (low blood pressure) - Hyperkalemia (high potassium levels) - Angioedema (swelling of the face, lips, throat, or tongue)
Synthroid (Levothyroxine)	Rapid or irregular heartbeat - Chest pain - Tremors - Nervousness - Insomnia - Heat intolerance
Xanax (Alprazolam)	Drowsiness - Fatigue - Dizziness - Memory impairment - Slurred speech - Increased salivation
Zithromax (Azithromycin)	Nausea - Vomiting - Diarrhea - Abdominal pain - Headache - Allergic reactions - QT prolonging
Zoloft (Sertraline)	Nausea - Diarrhea - Insomnia or drowsiness - Headache - Sexual dysfunction (such as decreased libido or difficulty achieving orgasm) - Weight gain or loss - Suicidal thoughts
