

Drugs 41-60 Side Effects

Medication (Brand/Generic Name)	Potential Side Effects
Advair (Fluticasone + Salmeterol)	Throat irritation - Hoarseness - Headache - Nausea - Vomiting - Diarrhea - Cough - Thrush (oral fungal infection)
Aleve (Naproxen)	Heartburn - Stomach pain - Nausea - Headache - Dizziness - Drowsiness - Rash
Zyrtec (Cetirizine)	Drowsiness - Dry mouth - Fatigue - Headache - Nausea - Sore throat - Stomach pain
Coreg (Carvedilol)	Dizziness or lightheadedness - Fatigue - Diarrhea - Slow heart rate - Weight gain - Shortness of breath - Erectile dysfunction (less common)
Crestor (Rosuvastatin) Mevacor (Lovastatin)	Muscle pain or weakness (myopathy) - Liver problems - Digestive issues (such as nausea, diarrhea, or constipation) - Increased blood sugar levels (especially in individuals with diabetes)
Cymbalta (Duloxetine) Paxil (Paroxetine)	Weight gain or loss - Nausea - Diarrhea - Insomnia or drowsiness - Headache - Sexual dysfunction (such as decreased libido or difficulty achieving orgasm) - Suicidal thoughts
Desyrel (Trazodone)	Drowsiness - Dizziness - Dry mouth - Blurred vision - Constipation - Weight gain - Priapism (prolonged, painful erection) (rare)
Diflucan (Fluconazole)	Nausea - Headache - Abdominal pain - Diarrhea - Rash - Liver toxicity (rare) - Allergic reactions (rare)
Diovan (Valsartan)	Dizziness - Fatigue - Low blood pressure (hypotension) - Hyperkalemia (high potassium levels) - Kidney problems (rare)
Effexor (Venlafaxine)	Nausea - Headache - Drowsiness - Dry mouth - Insomnia - Increased sweating - Sexual dysfunction (such as decreased libido or difficulty achieving orgasm)
Elavil (Amitriptyline)	Weight gain - Drowsiness - Dry mouth - Blurred vision - Constipation - Urinary retention - Confusion (especially in older adults)
Fosamax (Alendronate)	Nausea - Abdominal pain - Heartburn - Difficulty swallowing - Bone, joint, or muscle pain - Jaw bone problems (rare)
Klor-Con (Potassium chloride)	Nausea or vomiting - Abdominal discomfort - Diarrhea - Hyperkalemia (high potassium levels) - Gastrointestinal ulceration or bleeding (with extended-release formulations)
Mobic (Meloxicam)	Nausea - Stomach pain - Heartburn - Diarrhea - Dizziness - Headache - Rash
Valium (Diazepam)	Drowsiness - Fatigue - Dizziness - Memory impairment - Slurred speech - Increased salivation
Vibramycin (Doxycycline)	Nausea - Vomiting - Diarrhea - Rash - Photosensitivity (increased sensitivity to sunlight) - Yeast infection (oral or vaginal) - Esophageal irritation (if taken without sufficient water)
Minipress (Prazosin)	Dizziness or lightheadedness - Headache - Weakness - Drowsiness - Nausea - Palpitations - Fainting
Bystolic (Nebivolol)	Fatigue - Headache - Dizziness - Diarrhea - Nausea - Bradycardia (slow heart rate) - Hypotension (low blood pressure) - Erectile dysfunction (less common)
